On the first day of the week, Mary of Magdala came to the tomb early in the morning, while it was still dark, and saw the stone removed from the tomb.

So Peter and the other disciple went out and came to the tomb.

As we more fully realize what You have done for us.**


**Remember us, O Savior of us all, when You come into Your Kingdom,
